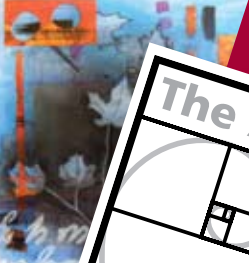

Our Programs

The Summer art immersion program is designed for motivated, artistically and career-minded teens ages 14 – 19 to help develop their ideas and build skills in the visual arts. The Junior Art Institute, ages 11-14 is specifically designed to prepare students for more advanced artistic explorations. We believe that every student should be given a firm foundation to build upon. Therefore, we explore the depth of shape, color, line, texture, space and movement as well as the importance of conceptualism to help students develop scholarship-level portfolios.

Art Institute & Junior Art Institute Staff

All Instructors are professional visual and media artists who teach from a mentor position — encouraging students to build their skills while becoming well-rounded and diversified in the visual arts. They also include illustrators, photographers and exhibiting visual artists. Some artists appear in national publications and are affiliated with professional organizations that focus on arts and education.

The Summer Art Intensive of the Art Institute is located in the **Fine Arts Studios, and Photo Lab at Vassar College** in Poughkeepsie on New Hackensack Rd. There are beautifully landscaped areas, historic buildings and the Lehman Loeb Museum that serve as inspiration. The Summer Intensive utilizes many studios including sculpture, a fully equipped darkroom with digital facilities, professional exhibit areas, dorms, and the expansive grounds and facilities.

Our Success Speaks For Itself

Our students have been accepted to the top schools in the nation, taking scholarships to, Pratt Institute, Carnegie Mellon, Maryland Institute College of Art, Fashion Institute of Technology, Rochester Institute of Technology, Rhode Island School of Design, Savannah College of Art & Design, School of the Museum of Fine Arts, School of Visual Arts, Columbus College of Art & Design & more. Most of our students improve their GPA by half a point the first year in the program, while becoming more involved in extra-curricular activities and community service. They score higher on their SAT's and have participated in group as well as solo exhibits. The Art Institute has the only non-high school affiliated chapter of the National Art Honor Society, Chapter #2242, in the nation.



Summer Intensive Residential Program

Enjoy the same great Summer Intensive program but with an added twist. Each participant will be enrolled in extended evening studio courses, special activities, and weekend excursions while living in the dorms on campus at Vassar College. In addition, Artist Resident Advisors will work in a mentor position with students.

Advanced Drawing & Painting

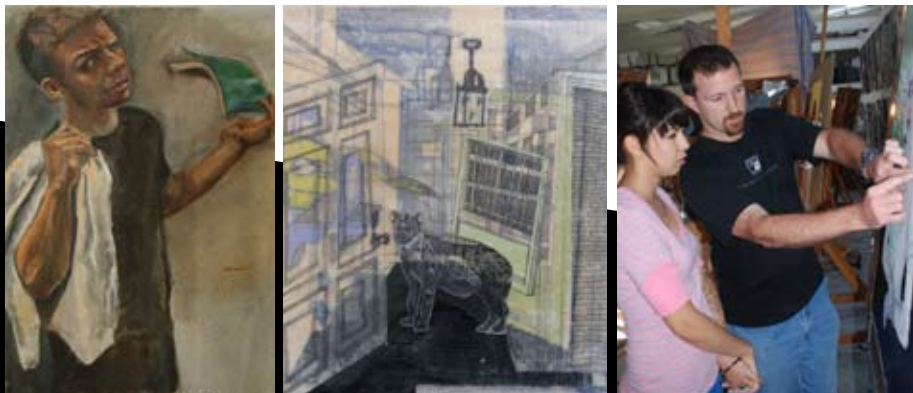
9:00 – 12:30 Adv. Drawing & Painting • lunch • 1 – 2:45 Photography • 2:50 – 4:30 Drawing II
Students will explore representational, abstract, and conceptual sensibilities. This **CONCENTRATION** uses a wide range of media from charcoal and pastel on paper; water-color and ink painting, mixed media and collage, and acrylic paint on canvas. Students learn to hone their skills of self-expression into personal statements and powerful works of art while developing their portfolios and entering into critiques and dialogues. **Students wishing to concentrate in Advanced Drawing & Painting are required to schedule an appointment with our director prior to enrollment. Drawing & Painting

9:00 – 12:30 Drawing & Painting • lunch • 1 – 2:45 Media • 2:50 – 4:30 Photography
An advanced foundation course which explores the principles of art & 2D design. Students will work from a variety of live references while exploring observational based representational and abstract forms as they develop higher level skills. In addition students will discover new drawing techniques and painting methods. This **CONCENTRATION** begins to prepare students for advanced study as they pursue portfolio development for college admission.

Photography

9:00 – 12:30 Photography • lunch • 1 – 2:45 Drawing II • 2:50 – 4:30 Digital Photography
Students explore photography as a medium for creative expression in our fully equipped darkroom and on our landscaped grounds. The emphasis will be on seeing – what is visually significant – and craftsmanship – mastering particular photographic techniques in order to create dynamic photographs. Students explore how a camera works, film processing, innovative techniques, and black-and-white printing. This **CONCENTRATION** gives students direct and practical experience while gaining an understanding of the wonders of photography.



Year-round (In Poughkeepsie, Beacon & Red Hook)

Portfolio Development I-IV

Each course helps the student to develop a solid portfolio and to understand the requirements of the best schools. Students learn how a professional artist creates and develops ideas and will begin to explore representational, and conceptual sensibilities.

Photography & Digital Photo

These courses emphasize composition through the art of seeing, with the accent on creative expression. Fine art black and white photography, dark-room techniques, printing skills, digital explorations and experimentation are explored in-studio and outdoors. Cameras may be provided.

Figure Drawing & Painting

We will cover basic human anatomy, gesture drawing, figure proportions, portraits, and long term poses using a variety of materials and techniques. Students will work from a live model and will explore composition through the human form, observation, and discussion.

Portraiture

Beginning and intermediate students will learn how to create portraits and self-portraits using a variety of media and approaches. Realism, self expression, anatomical proportions, form and planer studies are explored as students study portrait composition.

Sculpture & Welding

This course will explore the fundamentals of classical sculpture through various materials and study of 3 dimensional form. Skill building, techniques, art in the round, and mastery of media will be stressed while students study the works of master artists.

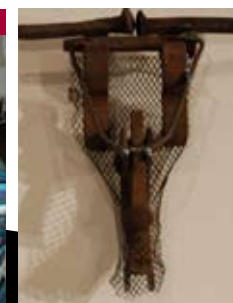
Drawing and Painting

Explore and expand understanding of spatial relationships, design, composition, form and value. We will incorporate vocabulary and art history while concentrating on skill development using charcoal, inks, pastels and acrylics, and translate our knowledge into expressive drawings and paintings.
